LEA's with a Title 1 allocation of \$700,000 or less	\$5,000

LEA's with a Title 1 allocation of \$1,200,000 or more	\$15,000

Individual school memberships are based on the school's percentage of their LEA's Title I allocation. (number of schools in the LEA divided by the LEA's membership cost)

Available via telephone as a resource for technical assistance and resource referral  
Complete Analysis of your school and/or district's compliance with NCLB's Parent Involvement Mandates.  
Includes Policy Review and report indicating the status of your compliance and recommendations for Best Practice according to current research and guidelines provided by the VT Dept of Education's title I team.

**School Climate Evaluation**

For Schools who are confident that their policies are in compliance, this evaluation consists of a site visit during which PIRC will conduct an assessment of your physical plant and conduct interviews. (Policies will not be reviewed)

**Complete Parent Involvement Evaluation**

In addition to the Policy Evaluation, the Complete Evaluation includes a site visit, which includes:  
parent, staff, and faculty interviews & School Climate Assessment
