

# Medicine Safety Puppet Program



## What to expect:

Joanne has a cold and is planning on taking medicine which her friend has given her. When Valerie learns this, she explains to Joanne that medicine should only be taken if it is given by adults who are taking care of you. 15 minute puppet skit including interactive question and answer period with audience.

## Key Program Points:

- Medicine is helpful when you are sick, but only if it is given to you by an adult who is taking care of you
- Identify adults who are caregivers
- Danger of taking medicine that is not yours
