

# Blindness/ Visual Impairment Workshop



**What to expect:** This 60 minute program includes a 10 minute puppet presentation and hands-on activities. The program is presented by a puppeteer/ educator who is blind. The hands-on activities include using a beeping ball, braille cards, listening to audio description, navigating with a cane, learning about tools people who are blind/ visually impaired use, and asking questions to our puppeteer/ educator who is blind.

## Key Program Points:

- Difference between blindness and visual impairment
- What people who are blind/ visually impaired CAN do
- Friendship tips
- What to do if you meet someone who is blind/ visually impaired
- Explore and learn about tools that people who are blind/ visually impaired use
- Ask questions about blindness and visual impairment
