- Offer Assistive Technology core services to folks in Southern/Eastern VT with A.T needs.
- Possess and provide consumers with a wide variety of A.T serving any and all disabilities.
- Pull out unique uses for tools/employ tools in ways that they wouldn't normally be associated.
- Provide multiple uses and cheaper options for tools w/consumer's financial well being in mind.
 - Example: Expensive Grabber Tool vs. Cheap Grill Tongs... creative!
 - Tech Loan Process:
 - Pre-Pandemic: Offer 30 day loans with extensions possible.
 - Currently: Loans are specific to high needs and high priority cases only.
 - For VR consumers, Tech is VR funded
 - For non VR consumers, Tech is paid for via fee schedule and other funding sources.
- Provide in-person, hands-on assessments to consumers with opportunities to fit and try out tech after specific tech needs are identified.
 - o A.T Specialist meet consumers where they are at
 - Example: Farmer vs High School Student- they will have very different life experiences and abilities, and A.T Specialists take this into consideration by providing very individualized services.
