  - $\checkmark$  Currently have 70 students with the capacity for 220.
  - ✓ Can apply any time by contacting recruiter (Gene), processing takes 2 to 4 weeks while the program can take 2 years
  - ✓ Students get a small monthly stipend, uniform and \$500 when they graduate
  - ✓ Welding program remains full, but plenty of space in other programs including construction technology, auto mechanics, culinary, office administration, and urban forestry
  - ✓ Working on rebuilding their work-based learning program
  - ✓ Also offer high school diploma and GED programs
  - ✓ Housing is now 1 to 2 students per room per covid guidelines
  - ✓ Updated security
