#### **Tech Check!**

Many of these resources require a certain internet speed/specs. Anyone can test their internet speeds for free at www.speedtest.net (about 8mbs download and 4mbs upload speeds are needed for virtual meetings like Zoom, more for more complex programs or employment opportunities.)

#### **Top Resources from Vermont Libraries:**

- LearningExpress -- a free resource through EBSCO which is available for FREE from your local library website. Registration takes less than two minutes, and this resource is a deep and broad tool that has something for everyone, from elementary school homework help, prep for the Commercial Driver's License (CDL) exam, nursing and medical testing prep, job interview and resume writing, computer skills, SAT, LSAT, and GRE test prep, to interactive tools to help someone choose a career. It can help someone choose a pathway in life or provide the tools to get a better job. This is a gamechanger—we've never seen something so extensive, comprehensive, and free to use like this! To access, you visit your local library's website and find "LearningExpress" which should be right on the homepage.
- Vermont Online Library -- Vermont's robust statewide Interlibrary Loan program called Clover (Collaborative Libraries Of VERmont) allows every library in the state to borrow and lend within Vermont. VTLIB also facilitates borrowing from out-of-state libraries when in-state resources are unavailable. Interlibrary loan services work to make sure your library resources beyond its four walls.
- Universal Class -- More than 500 online classes ranging in topics from writing skills, software programs (including Adobe and Microsoft programs), to science, html, and graphic design. There's something for everyone!
- Interlibrary Loan -- Vermont's robust statewide Interlibrary Loan program called Clover (Collaborative Libraries Of VERmont) allows every library in the state to borrow and lend within Vermont. VTLIB also facilitates borrowing from out-of-state libraries when in-state resources are unavailable. Interlibrary loan services work to make sure your library resources beyond its four walls.

- CCV is offering lots of Free Trainings for Vermonters Impacted by COVID-19!
  - The COVID-19 pandemic has affected us all; some more than others. For anyone who has had their job cut, hours reduced, or been laid off or furloughed, the State wants to help you upskill, reskill, and be skilled for the jobs that are here in Vermont.
  - CCV and the Vermont State Colleges System, in collaboration with the Vermont Department of Labor, are offering FREE classes and training for Vermont workers who have been impacted by COVID-19. This funding can also be used for support services to help you access your education, such as computers, internet, or child care. This opportunity is only available through December 31.

- Black River Innovation Campus--Master Remote Work Certificate Course
  - Rolling admissions. Cost is \$300.
  - This course combines online work with interactive workshops and is designed to equip participants with the basic tools and skills needed to work from home as a remote worker, freelancer, or entrepreneur. This certificate course consists of nine core modules delivered in a self-paced, online format and is integrated with interactive virtual workshops hosted via video conference.
  - Completion of this certificate program awards special access to jobs offered by BRIC affiliates and is a pre-requisite to applying for these jobs. While jobs cannot be guaranteed, successful participants will have a leg up on the competition and will be well-prepared to successfully enter a remote-work environment.

- Because this is an online course, applicants should have some online/technical experience, such as having taken online classes in the past, or the ability to have a coach or mentor assist them through it. There are scheduled videoconferences in addition to self-paced work, so availability should be reviewed as well.

- The cost of this program is \$300, however, there are some scholarship funds available. Applicants need to fill out the online application and submit a resume. There's no financial commitment until applications are reviewed and students are accepted into the program, at which point they will be notified of any scholarships they've received or if they'd owe the \$300 course fee.
- Black River Innovation Campus--Flatiron Software Development/Data Science Course
  - The Black River Innovation Campus in Springfield, VT, in collaboration with Flatiron School and the Center on Rural Innovation, is offering our second round of a comprehensive software development or data science bootcamp to people in Vermont and New Hampshire.
  - The course, which takes 5 months full-time (at 40 hours/week) or 10 months parttime (20hrs/week), **is available fully online** and extra support/coaching will be available through BRIC staff in Springfield.
  - In addition to the education provided by the Flatiron School, CORI and BRIC will facilitate career support for program students, helping to identify and apply for local jobs or jobs that can be conducted remotely from BRIC.
  - The program offers a creative financing model to allow more people to take advantage of the opportunity. Instead of paying tuition up front, students can access Flatiron School Income Share Agreements
     (https://flatironschool.com/income-share-agreement-isa-online), and make payments only after they've left the program and are earning at least \$40,000/year.
