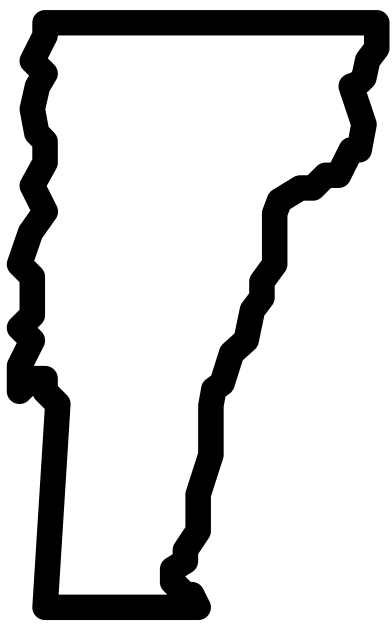


SDM Strong!

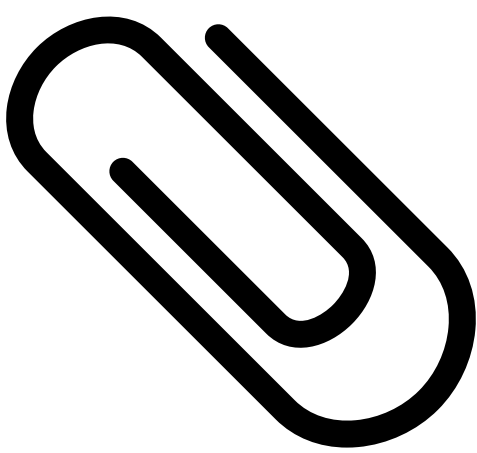
Where
