The partnership of HireAbility (formerly Vocational Rehabilitation), VABIR (Vermont Association of Business, Industry, and Rehabilitation), and VCAP (Vermont Career Advancement Project)

These three providers work hand in hand. HireAbility Vocational Counselors provide the case management, planning, and resource access for participants who have health based barriers to employment. VABIR Business Account Manager and Employment Consultants partner directly with Vocational Counselors. They assist our participants with employer contacts, readiness for work, job development, and work adjustment. The VCAP program enhances HireAbility services for individuals who are specifically seeking or engaged in training.
