All Sibshops are on Saturdays from 1:00-3:00 pm unless otherwise noted. Each Sibshop includes an activity, a snack, and a facilitated Sibchat. Every Sibchat has a theme and will provide an opportunity for participants to connect around what it means to be a “sib.” The \$10 Sibshop fee covers all food and activities.

We are aware that some families may have concerns about COVID-19 and in-person activities. Our staff will be monitoring Vermont’s COVID rates and guidelines/ mandates carefully, and we are prepared to adjust activities as needed. We are able to host virtual Sibshops and have planned a few fun virtual themes in the event that we need to do so.

It is located on the second floor of an historic building. Currently, access to the 2nd floor is by stairs only. Plans for renovation, including the addition of an elevator, will begin in 2023.
