- Update on each agency and or school. HireAbility talked about Summer Career Exploration Program, Vermont Career Advance Program. Spoke about how the youth that can be served can be as young as 16 if their moving forward with training and or education. It could be a good next step upon SCEP or if there is a lot of motivation and it make sense to have them be apart of the program.
- Lacey explained the JOBS program and how it's looking with her as the Program Manager. She talked about how she's able to work with individuals out within the community. She is meeting with some youth within Mount Anthony Union High School and Burr and Burton Academy. She's open to referrals and provided her contact information for anyone to ask her questions or reach out if they thought it was a good referral.
